Rothwell Conservation Area

Notice is hereby given that the Administrative Council of the Borough of Kettering in pursuance of its powers under

Section 277 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, as amended by Section 1 of the Town and Country Amenities Act 1974, has designated part of Rothwell as a Conservation Area.

The effect of the designation is summarised as follows:

(1) Anyone wishing to demolish a building or part of a building within the Conservation Area must first apply for consent therefor to the Borough Council as Local Planning Authority. Certain buildings are excluded from this requirement.

(2) Anyone wishing to cut down, top, lop, uproot or damage any tree in the Conservation Area must give the Borough Council 6 weeks' notice of his intention so to do.

The Conservation Area includes part of the town of Rothwell and is defined on a plan which may be inspected at the Municipal Offices, Bowling Green Road, Kettering during normal office hours.—Dated 4th April 1978.

*The Lambeth (Prescribed Routes) (No.)
Traffic Order 197*

Notice is hereby given that the Greater London Council propose to make the above-mentioned Order under Section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968 and the Road Traffic Act 1974.

2 The general effect of the Order would be consequent upon the carrying out of certain road works:

(a) to compel the left turn by vehicular traffic from Macaulay Road into Clapham Common North Side;

(b) to compel vehicular traffic entering Clapham Common North Side from the northern access to Holy Trinity Church, Clapham Common to turn right into Clapham Common North Side;

(c) to prevent the right turn by vehicular traffic from Clapham Common North Side into the northern access to Holy Trinity Church, Clapham Common;

(d) to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding from Rookery Road into Macaulay Road.

3 The requirements referred to in paragraph 2 (a) and (b) above would not apply in respect of anything above with

the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
