WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of West Sussex (Pulborough: Stopham Road (A.283)) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the West Sussex County Council have made an Order under the provisions of section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit vehicles from waiting at any time on the south side of Stopham Road (A.283), Pulborough, from the east side of the railway bridge westwards to a point 3 metres west of the western boundary of No. 11 Stopham Road (A.283).

Exceptions are provided in the Order to allow vehicles to stop and pick up and set down passengers, goods or merchandise, to wait when engaged in building operations or the repair of the roads, or the services therein, to take in petrol, oil, air or water from a garage and in connection with funerals. Invalid carriages, and disabled person's vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges or Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975, and a parking disc will be permitted to wait in the length of road mentioned above, for a period of up to 2 hours, their return being prohibited within 1 hour.

A copy of the Order which will come into operation on 12th April 1978, and a map showing the length of road to which the Order relates may be inspected at the County Hall, Chichester, during normal office hours.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks from 5th April 1978, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The County Council of West Sussex (Steyning: Elm Grove Lane) (Experimental Prohibition of Driving) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the West Sussex County Council propose to make an Order under the provisions of section 9 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and by Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be to prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to proceed in Elm Grove Lane, Steyning, between its junction with the High Street (A.283) and Tanyard Lane.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable vehicles to proceed along the length of road referred to if the vehicle is being used:

- (i) for conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated in that length of road;
- (ii) in connection with any building operation, or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the repair of the roads or the services therein;
- (iii) for the purpose of agriculture or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land;
- (iv) in the service of a local authority;
- (v) is a public service vehicle, whilst being used as a stage carriage; or
- (vi) for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
