

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of West Sussex (Sompting: West Street (B.2222) and Associated Roads) (Prohibition of Commercial Vehicles of over 3 tons) Order 1978.

Notice is hereby given that on 12th April 1978 the West Sussex County Council made an Order under the provisions of section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, section 1 of the Heavy Commercial Vehicles (Controls and Regulations) Act 1973, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit any heavy commercial vehicle the weight of which unladen exceeds 3 tons to proceed in the following lengths of road in Worthing and the Parish of Sompting:

West Street, from Upper Brighton Road to Loose Lane.

Church Lane, from West Street to A.27 Sompting By-Pass.

Newmans Gardens, for its entire length.

Upper Brighton Road, Worthing, from 20 metres east of The Templars to West Street.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable heavy commercial vehicles to proceed in the above mentioned roads if being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to any of those roads; for the purpose of agriculture in connection with land in or adjacent to those lengths of road or for the conveyance of timber felled upon the land; in connection with any building or industrial operation, demolition or removal of any obstruction to traffic in those lengths of road; the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or any telegraphic line, in or adjacent to those lengths of road; in any emergency for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes; in the service of a local authority in the pursuance of statutory powers; for the conveyance of goods for sale from the vehicle; or if the vehicle is to be garaged or serviced at any premises in those lengths of road.

A copy of the Order which will come into operation on 19th April 1978, and a map showing the lengths of road to which the Order relates may be inspected at the County Hall, Chichester, during normal office hours.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks from 12th April 1978, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone (Bognor Regis) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the West Sussex County Council made an Order on 12th April 1978, under the provisions of sections 35, 36, 37, 39 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which is to vary the charges for parking between 9.0 a.m. and 6.0 p.m. on all days between Good Friday and the first Sunday in October, in each year, in the parking bays situated in The Esplanade and Marine Drive West, Bognor Regis, as follows:

Cars

Entry before 1.30 p.m., £1.00.

Entry between 1.30 p.m. and 4.0 p.m., 50p.

Entry after 4.0 p.m., 20p.

Motor-Cycles

Entry before 1.30 p.m., 50p.

Entry between 1.30 p.m. and 4.0 p.m. 25p.

Entry after 4.0 p.m., 10p.

The £1.00 ticket for a car and the 50p. ticket for a motor-cycle will entitle the ticket-holder to park in any on-street or off-street car park in Arun District on the same day without further charge.

The charges for parking of cars and motor-cycles for longer than a day will be £8.50 per season, £6.00 per month, £3.00 per week.

The West Sussex County Council (Bognor Regis: The Esplanade) (Public Service Vehicle Stands) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that on 12th April 1978, the West Sussex County Council made an Order under the provisions of section 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which establishes a coach stand to operate between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 7.30 p.m. daily from 1st April to 30th September inclusive in each year on that length of The Esplanade, Bognor Regis, which extends from a point 12 metres west of the eastern kerbline of the western carriageway of Waterloo Square, eastwards for 13 metres and being 2.75 metres in width.

The West Sussex County Council (Donnington: St. Georges Drive (B.2201)) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that on 12th April 1978, West Sussex County Council made an Order under the provisions of section 74 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and by Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which is to prohibit any person from driving a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h. on that length of St. Georges Drive in the Parish of Donnington which extends from the south-eastern kerbline of Road A.286 (Stockbridge Road and Birdham Road), south-eastwards and southwards to a point 10 metres south of the southern kerbline of Selsey Road at its southern junction with St. Georges Drive, a distance of 399 metres.
