MID GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

Mid Glamorgan County Council (Nantgarw Road (Route A.468) Caerphilly) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Mid Glamorgan propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 the effect of which will be:

- (i) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the northern side of Nantgarw Road (A.468) Caerphilly between the western side of its junction with Tafwys Walk to the eastern side of its junction with the land adjacent to the flank frontage of number 172, Nantgarw Road, a distance of approximately 486 metres (532 yards) and
- (ii) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on the southern side of Nantgarw Road (A.468) Caerphilly, between the western side of its junction with Crescent Road and the eastern side of its junction with the lane adjacent to the flank frontage of number 129, Nantgarw Road, a distance of approximately 292 metres (319 yards).

Exemptions will be provided in the Order for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, building and road works, the maintenance of essential services, funerals and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office. Disabled persons' vehicles displaying the relevant disabled person's badge will be allowed to wait for up to 2 hours with return prohibited within 1 hour.

A copy of the proposed Order, a Statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order and a map showing the sides of lengths of road to which the proposed Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Rhymney Valley District Council, Council Offices, Park Road, Hengoed and at the Mid Glamorgan County Hall, Cathays Park, Cardiff, during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposal together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 8th May 1978.

Mid Glamorgan County Council (Bute Street, Treherbert) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that on 5th April 1978 the Mid Glamorgan County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the south western side of Bute Street, Treherbert, for a distance of 10 metres (11 yards):

- (i) northwest of the north western side of the lane access between Nos. 130 and 131A Bute Street;

- (ii) south eastwards of the south eastern side of the lane access between Nos. 130 and 131A Bute Street, Treherbert.

Exemptions are provided in the Order for the purpose of boarding alighting, loading and unloading, building and road works, the maintenance of essential services, funerals and the delivery of collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office.
