- (16) Market Place (i) On the north-east side from Snuff Street for 73 metres south-westwards. (ii) On the south-east side from St. John's Street to Little Brittox and the entrance to The Shambles—(this length to be partly a taxi-rank only and partly a loading bay); (iii) On the south-east side for about 4 metres from St. John's Street towards Castle Lane; (iv) For about 9 metres along Corn Exchange frontage at Station Road junction; (v) On south-west side from Station Road for about 52 metres north-westwards.
- (17) Station Road—extend from a point 134 metres west of Market Place to a point 280 metres west.
- (18) St. John's Street-2 metres extension by The Chequers.
- (19) Sutton Place—from its junction with Hare and Hounds Street for 31 metres southwards.
- (B) To extend the loading ban on Mondays to Saturdays between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. so as to include a length on the north-east side of High Street, Devizes for 54 metres from Wine Street and also the frontage of The Brittox with Wine Street.
- (C) To include a provision for prohibition of waiting between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the following lengths of road in Devizes:
- (1) Bridewell Street-On the south-east side from a point 53 metres north-east from Long Street for 15 metres northeastwards.
- (2) High Street—On the south-west side from a point 3 metres south-east from Wine Street for 24 metres southeastwards (Loading bay).
- (3) Sidmouth Street (i) On the north side from a point 49 metres east of Monday Market Street for 12 metres eastwards. (ii) On the south side from a point 85 metres east of Sheep Street for 13 metres eastwards. (Loading bays.)
- (D) The provisions in the existing Orders for prohibition and resetriction of waiting are to be revoked and re-enacted in the new Order, taking into account the restric-tions proposed in (A), (B) and (C) above. The usual exemptions will be included in the new Order, including those applicable to disabled drivers' vehicles.
- (E) The existing provisions for one-way working of traffic on Monday Market Street, Maryport Street and Snuff Street are re-enacted in a new one-way Order.

South side—from a point 45.72 metres west of its junction with New Park Street to a point 70 metres west of that junction.

- (i) South-west side-from a point 3 metres south-east of its junction with Station Road to a point 9 metres southeast of that junction.

(ii) South-west side-from a point 2.75 metres north-west of its junction with Station Road to a point 9.14 metres

north-west of that junction.

i) South-west side—from a point 32 metres north-west of its junction with Station Road to a point 49 metres (iii) South-west side-

of its junction with Station Road to a point 49 metres north-west of that junction.

(iv) South-east side—from the Little Brittox to a point 14 metres from its junction with St. John's Street and along the frontage of The Shambles.

(v) North-east side—from a point 32 metres south-east of its junction with Snuff Street to a point 73 metres

south-east of that junction.

(vi) South-east side—from a point 2.74 metres south-west of its junction with St. John's Street to a point 6 metres south-west of that junction.

(8) Estcourt Street

(i) North side—from a point 47.55 metres east of its junction with Gains Lane to a point 54 metres east of that junction, and from a point 63 metres east of that junction for 5 metres eastwards.

(ii) North side—from a point 86 metres east of Gains Lane to a point 111.56 metres east of that junction.

(Pelican crossing approach).

(iii) South side—from a point 38.41 metres east of its junction with Southbroom Road to a point 72.14 metres east of that junction.
