If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for confirmation any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted to the Secretary of State with the Order.

##### *Chesterfield Borough Council (Red Lane—Station Lane) (Part) Public Path Diversion Order 1977*

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order made on the 6th April 1978 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed as an unopposed Order by the Chesterfield Borough Council.
