Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transpont Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The Order will come into operation on the 25th April 1978.

When this Order comes into effect:-
(a) waiting will be prohibited at any time on the southeastern side of Cecil Road from a point 55 metres ( 180 feet) south-west of its junction with Sea Road for a distance of 21 metres ( 70 feet) in a south-westerly direction;
(b) waiting will be prohibited at any time from 15th March to 31st October inclusive in any year on the south-eastern side of Cecil Road from a point 76 metres ( 250 feet) south-west of its junation with Sea Road for a distance of 21 metres ( 70 feet) in a southwesterly direction;
(c) waiting will be prohibited between 10 a.m. and $10 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$. on the whole length of the western side of Grantley Road;
(d) Public Service Vehicles will be exempted from waiting restrictions while waiting on any duly authorised Public Service Vehicle Stand.
The usual exceptions will apply to loading and unloading goods, picking up and setting down passengers and certain works.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act as amended or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 4th April 1978 apply to the High Court for this purpose.-Dated 5th April 1978.
