TYNE AND WEAR COUNTY COUNCIL

The Tyne and Wear County Council
(Swing Bridge, Newcastle upon Tyne)
(Prohibition of Driving and Pedestrians) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that on 18th April 1978, Tyne and Wear County Council made an Order under Section 1 (1), (2), (3) and (3B) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order is:

- (1) to prohibit driving on the Swing Bridge and its adjoining approach roads between a point 12 metres north of the northern kerbline of Pipewellgate, Gateshead and the southern kerbline of Sandhill, Newcastle upon Tyne, when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.
- (2) to prohibit pedestrians from proceeding on the Swing Bridge, and its adjoining approach roads between a point 12 metres north of the northern kerbline of Pipewellgate, Gateshead and a point 34 metres south of the southern kerbline of Sandhill, Newcastle when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.
