1. To revoke the County Council of Isle of Wight (Various Streets, Brading) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1975.
2. To re-enact the provisions contained in the above Order subject to the following amendments:

- (a) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in the following lengths of road:

Mall Road on east side from a point 240 feet south of the Bull Ring to a point 570 feet north of Brading Down Road.
