The Borough of Rhuddlan (Traffic Regulation) (Sussex Street Rhyll—No. 1) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that on the 17th April 1977 the Rhuddlan Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act, 1972 with the Clwyd County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 the effect of which will be as shown in the Schedule to this notice. The Order will come into operation on 24th April 1978.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the length of road affected are available for inspection at the Borough Secretary's Department, Council Offices, Upper Denbigh Road, St. Asaph, during normal office hours. Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act, 1972, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from 24th April 1978 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

- (c) to enable a vehicle to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties;
- (d) to enable a vehicle to be used for the loading or unloading of goods;
- (e) a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge; loading and unloading being restricted to 45 minutes in any two hours return prohibited within 75 minutes

RHUDDLAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Rhuddlan (Gas Works Lane Prestatyn) (Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that on the 17th April 1978 the Rhuddlan Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Clwyd County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972. Under the terms of the Order no vehicle will be permitted to proceed along that part of Gas Works Lane, Prestatyn, commencing 90 feet south-west of its junction with Penisadre Road, Prestatyn, to its junction with the Mineral Railway in either direction except to gain access to premises thereon.

The Order will come into operation on 24th April 1978.
