The Warwickshire County Council (Footpath S.D. 16, Luddington) Public Path Diversion Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") made on 30th March 1978 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed by the Warwickshire County Council as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert that part of footpath SD 16 which runs from a point on the Stratford-Evesham Road, A439, 174 metres west of Dodwell Cottages, north-north-westwards for 460 metres to a line running from a point on the A439 road 344 metres west of Dodwell Cottages generally northwards for 430 metres to join the existing route of the footpath.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited, and may be inspected free of charge at the Office of the County Secretary, Shire Hall, Warwick, at the Office of the Secretary of the Stratford-on-Avon District Council, Council Offices, Birmingham Road, Stratford-upon-Avon on Mondays to Fridays inclusive during normal office hours.

Compensation for depreciation or damage in consequence of the coming into operation of this Order is payable in accordance with section 113(2) of the above Highways Act 1959 to which reference should be made.

Any objection or representation concerning the Order may be sent in writing to the undersigned at Shire Hall, Warwick before 29th May 1978 and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Warwickshire County Council may, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, themselves confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for confirmation any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent to him with the Order.

The Warwickshire County Council (Bridleway SS.3 and Footpath SS.3c Butlers Marston) Public Path Diversion Order 1978.

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") made on 10th April 1978 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed by the Warwickshire County Council as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert:

(a) that part of bridleway SS.3 which runs from the western extremity of bridleway SS.3e 119 metres south-south-west of Oxhouse Farm, north-eastwards for 70 metres, then east-north-eastwards for 22 metres, then generally east-south-eastwards for 710 metres to a line running from the first point mentioned, generally south-eastwards following the route of bridleway SS.3e for 590 metres, then turning to head north-north-eastwards for 150 metres, then east-south-eastwards for 100 metres, then east-north-eastwards for 100 metres to join the existing route of the bridleway.

(b) that part of footpath SS.3c which runs from the south-western end of the footbridge over the River Dene south-westwards for 84 metres to a line running from the footbridge, generally eastwards following the southern bank of the River for 330 metres then east-south-eastwards for 30 metres, then turning to head southwards for 90 metres, then west-south-westwards for 90 metres to join bridleway SS.3.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at, and may be inspected free of charge at the Office of the County Secretary, Shire Hall, Warwick, and at the Divisional Engineer's Office, Loxley Road, Wellesbourne on Mondays to Fridays inclusive during normal office hours.
