

And whereas the Council have resolved to vary the Principal Order in the manner hereinafter appearing:

Now therefore the Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, hereby make the following Order:

- (1) This Order may be cited as The Brent No. 7 (Sudbury) Smoke Control (Variation) Order 1978.
- (2) The Principal Order shall be varied as follows:
The dwelling in the said area which is specified in the Schedule to this Order shall cease to be exempt from the operation of the said Section 11.
- (3) This Order shall come into operation on 1st December 1978. Copies of the Variation Order may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Forty Lane, Wembley, Middlesex, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from 28th April 1978. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Queen Anne's Chambers, 28 Broadway, London, SW1H 9JU object to the confirmation of the Order.

HIGH PEAK BOROUGH COUNCIL

CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

Council of the Borough of High Peak (Buxton No. 2) Smoke Control Revocation Order 1977

Notice is hereby given that the above Smoke Control Revocation Order was made by the High Peak Borough Council on 22nd September 1977 and thereafter submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation. The effect of this Order would be to revoke the Council of the Borough of High Peak (Buxton No. 2) Smoke Control Order 1975, which is due to come into operation on 1st June 1978, or on such later date as may be appointed.

Notice is hereby given that, following a public inquiry held on 8th February 1978, the Secretary of State for the Environment has decided not to confirm the Council of the Borough of High Peak (Buxton No. 2) Smoke Control Revocation Order 1977.

The effect of this is that the Council of the Borough of High Peak (Buxton No. 2) Smoke Control Order 1975 remains in force to come into operation on 1st June 1978. It should be noted however that the High Peak Borough Council, at their meeting on 27th May 1978, will be recommended to postpone the operative date of this Smoke Control Order, subject to the approval of the Secretary of State for the Environment, until 30th September 1979; in which case a further notice to that effect will be published.

ASHFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Ashford Borough (Edinburgh Road and Stone Street, Ashford) (Experimental One-way Traffic) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the Ashford Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Kent County Council propose to make an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

2. When this Order comes into operation it will have the following effect:

- (a) No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the roads or lengths of roads specified in Column 1 hereunder in a direction other than that specified in

relation to those roads or lengths of roads as the case may be in column 2 hereunder:

- (b) This experimental Order will apply for an initial period of six months to enable the Council to evaluate the proposals, but the provisions may be extended by Order in six months periods to a maximum period of eighteen months from the date the provisions first came into operation.

Full details of these proposals are in a draft Order which together with a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the offices of the Borough Secretary, Ashford Borough Council, Elwick House, Elwick Road, Ashford, Kent and in Room 1.97, County Hall, Maidstone, Kent between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

BEDFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Bedfordshire (Various Roads, Upper Sundon) (Width Restriction) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the Bedfordshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which will be to prohibit the driving of any vehicle (excluding public service vehicles) the width of which, inclusive of any load on the vehicle, exceeds 6 feet 6 inches in the roads and lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order permitting such vehicles to use these roads and lengths of road for the purpose of conveying persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises in the roads or lengths of road, for the purposes of agriculture, mineral workings or forestry in connection with land adjacent to the roads or lengths of road, in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the roads or lengths of road or the services therein.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a map showing the roads and lengths of road concerned and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined during normal office hours at my office at County Hall, Bedford, and at the offices of the Administration Executive, South Bedfordshire District Council, Grove House, Dunstable.
