The Borough of Blackpool (Central Area Traffic Routes) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and One-Way Traffic) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that on the 20th April 1978 the Blackpool Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Lancashire County Council, made the above Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and section 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be to:

- (1) Prohibit vehicles from proceeding in those roads or lengths of road detailed in Schedule 1 below other than in the direction indicated.
- (2) Prohibit waiting at all times in the lengths of road detailed in Schedule 2 below.
- (3) Permit vehicles to travel in either direction in that length of road detailed in Schedule 3 below.

A copy of the Order, which will take effect on the 7th May 1978, and a map showing the lengths of road affected are available at the Town Hall, Blackpool, where they may be examined during normal office hours in the Borough Surveyor's Department.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 (amended as aforesaid), or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may, within 6 weeks from the date of this notice, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Borough of Blackpool (King Street and George Street) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that on 14th April 1978, the Blackpool Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Lancashire County Council, made the above Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order which will come into operation on 7th May 1978 is to prohibit any vehicle from entering Deansgate from King Street or from entering or leaving Cookson Street at its junction with that length of George Street as lies to the west of Cookson Street.

A copy of the Order and of a map showing the roads affected may be inspected during normal office hours at the address below.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made

under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from the date of this notice apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Borough of Blackpool (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and One-Way Traffic) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 1978.

Notice is hereby given that on 14th April 1978 the Blackpool Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, with the Lancashire County Council, made the above Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972.

The effect of the Order which will come into operation on 22nd May 1978 is to prohibit vehicles from travelling on
