*The District of Huntingdon (Sheep Market, St. Ives) (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1978*

Notice is hereby given that the Huntingdon District Council propose to make an Order under Section 31(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 to control the use of the parking places named in the Schedule to this notice, which shows the class of vehicles, the days and times of operation, the maximum period for waiting and the scale of charges proposed for each parking place.

The Order will specify the conditions under which the parking places may be used. Full details are contained in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the location of the parking places, may be seen at:—

(a) Pathfinder House, St. Mary's Street, Huntingdon—During normal office hours.

(b) The Town Hall, St. Ives—During the Town Clerk's normal office hours.

*The District of Huntingdon (Off Street Parking Places) (Variation No. 1) Order 1978*

Notice is hereby given that the Huntingdon District Council in exercise of their powers under sections 31 (1) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972, propose to make the above mentioned Order, the effect of which will be as from 15th May 1978, to amend the District of Huntingdon (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1977, so that the standard charge to be made if a vehicle is left in a parking place during the charging hours for longer than the initial period for which payment is made by the initial charge, shall be increased from £4 plus VAT to £8 plus VAT.

Objections to the proposed Order, indicating the grounds upon which they are made, should be submitted to the undersigned in writing by not later than 13th May 1978.

## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Lancashire County Council (Lowergate, Clitheroe, Ribble Valley Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Revocation) (Amendment) Order 1978.*

Notice is hereby given that the Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to:—

(i) to revoke that part of the Lancashire County Council (Various Streets, Clitheroe) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1968, which relates to the length of road shown in the Schedule to this Notice, and which allows limited waiting on this length of road; and

(ii) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at all times on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

The Order contains exemptions to allow vehicles to wait for as long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded; to enable persons to board or alight or to enable it to be used in connection with any building

operation or demolition and the maintenance of essential services.

A copy of the Order and plan may be inspected at the offices of the Ribble Valley Borough Council, The Castle, Clitheroe, and at County Hall, Preston (Chief Executive/Clerk's Department) during normal office hours.

The Order comes into force on 1st May 1978.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order may within 6 weeks of 18th April 1978 apply to the High Court for that purpose.
