not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any of the requirements of the Act, or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 1st May 1978, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
