##### PART I

###### *Description of Site of Existing Paths*

(1) Path reference number MM1 commencing at Point A in Foot Lane in the Parish of Chelveston and running in an approximately westerly direction within O.P. 9241, O.S. Sheet SP9869, 1973 Edition for a distance of 85 metres to Point B.

(2) Path reference number MM3 commencing at Point A in Foot Lane in the Parish of Chelveston and running in an approximately southerly direction within O.P. 9241, O.S. Sheet SP9869, 1973 Edition for a distance of 90 metres to Point C.

(3) Path reference number MM4 commencing at Point A in Foot Lane in the Parish of Chelveston and running in an approximately westerly direction across O.P. 9241, O.S. Sheet SP9869, 1973 Edition for a distance of 123 metres to Point D thence in a generally south-westerly direction along the rear of the garage block in Hillside for a distance of 17 metres to Point E.

(4) Path reference number MM5 commencing at Point A in Foot Lane in the Parish of Chelveston and running in an approximately south-westerly direction within O.P. 9241, O.S. Sheet SP9869, 1973 Edition for a distance of 76 metres to Point F.

##### PART II

###### *Description of Site of New Paths*

(1) Path reference number MM1 being of a width of 2 metres commencing at Point A as above and running in a generally north-westerly direction (adjacent to the northern boundary of O.P. 9241, O.S. Sheet SP9869, 1973 Edition) for a distance of 20 metres to Point G, thence in a generally westerly and south-westerly direction along the new highway to be known as Duchy Close for a distance of 92 metres to Point H, and thence in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 22 metres to Point B.

(2) Path reference number MM3 being of a width of 2 metres commencing at Point A and running to Point G as above, thence in a southerly direction along the new highway to be known as Duchy Close for a distance of 77 metres to Point J and thence in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 30 metres to Point C.

(3) Path reference number MM4 being of a width of 2 metres commencing at Point A and following the new route of Path reference number MM1 to Point H as above, thence in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 50 metres to Point E.

(4) Path reference number MM5 being of a width of 2 metres commencing at Point A and following the new route of Path reference number MM3 to Point J as above, thence in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 47 metres to Point F. (578)
