

12. Uniting the benefices of Bampton with Mardale; and Lowther cum Askham, in the diocese of Carlisle.

13. Declaring redundant the church of the Holy Trinity, Beaminster, a chapel of ease in the parish of Beaminster, in the diocese of Salisbury.

14. (1) Providing for a new place of worship within the parish of Saint Stephen, Willenhall, in the diocese of Lichfield (2) declaring redundant the existing parish church of the said parish, and (3) providing for the demolition of the existing church and empowering the said Commissioners to sell its site and the land annexed or belonging thereto.

15. Creating the new benefice and parish of Ireland Wood from part of the parish of Adel, in the diocese of Ripon.

16. Uniting the benefices of Moreton Hampstead; Manaton; and North Bovey, in the diocese of Exeter, and altering the name of the parish of Moreton Hampstead.

17. Establishing a team ministry for the area of the benefice of Dunstable, in the diocese of Saint Albans.

18. Altering the areas of the parishes of Romford; and Saint George, Harold Hill, in the diocese of Chelmsford.

Appropriating the tower of the redundant church of Saint Mary, Ewell, in the diocese of Guildford, and part of the land annexed or belonging thereto to use as a display centre and for purposes ancillary thereto, and empowering the Guildford Diocesan Board of Finance to lease the said tower and land for the said uses.

26. Uniting the benefices of North Newton with Saint Michaelchurch and Thurloxton; and Durston, in the diocese of Bath and Wells.

27. (1) Providing a new place of worship within the parish of Plaistow, Saint Mary, in the diocese of Chelmsford; (2) declaring redundant the existing parish church of the said parish and providing for its demolition; (3) empowering the said Commissioners to give part of the site of the said church and the land annexed or belonging thereto for use as part of the site of the new place of worship and to sell or lease the remaining part of the existing site.
