The Northamptonshire County Council (Pebble Lane, Wellingborough) (Parking Place for Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order.

Notice is hereby given that the Northamptonshire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 28 (1) and 31 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974, the effect of which will be to designate the following length of road for use as a parking place for disabled persons' vehicles bearing the relevant badge:

Pebble Lane, Wellingborough, north-east side, from a point 75 yards north-west of its junction with Market Street to a point 95 yards north-west of that junction.

The parking place will be available for use on all days and at all times although the maximum period for which vehicles may wait will be limited to 24 hours.

NORTHAMPTONSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Northamptonshire County Council (Market Street and Pebble Lane, Wellingborough) (Experimental Prohibition of Driving) Order.

Notice is hereby given that the Northamptonshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 the effect of which will be that no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road detailed in the Schedule to this notice. Exemptions to the Order will allow vehicles requiring access to premises to enter the restricted roads before 10 a.m. or after 4 p.m. on any day. Disabled drivers' vehicles requiring access to premises alongside the restricted roads and emergency vehicles will be allowed to use the lengths of roads at all times.

The Order, if implemented, will be in force initially for a period of six months but may be extended for two

further six month periods to enable the restriction to be evaluated.

NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Central Core, Nottingham) (Experimental Amendment) (No. 2) (B) Order 1978.

Notice is hereby given that the Nottinghamshire County Council has made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended. The Order will be of an experimental nature, imposing and relaxing waiting restrictions in the Central Core of the City of Nottingham. The changes are to allow on-street parking at a selected site on Angel Row of up to 30 minutes in any one hour between 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive. That same part of Angel Row will be subject to a total prohibition of waiting between 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between 4.30 p.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive. Other parts of Angel Row will be subject to a total prohibition of waiting.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of the provisions contained in it on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, not later than 9th June 1978 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Order will come into operation on 29th April 1978.
