The Essex County Council (Footpath 20, Elmstead) Public Path Diversion Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") made on 7th April 1978 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed by the Essex County Council as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert the public right of way running from Keelars Lane in Elmstead (point B on the plan attached to the Order) westwards for a distance of approximately 1,480 feet to point A on the plan to a line running from point A eastwards for approximately 1,430 feet to Keelars Lane at point C on the plan, approximately 80 feet south of the original point B.
