

At the Court at Buckingham Palace the 25th day of July 1978

PRESENT,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas the Secretary of State for the Environment, after giving to the Incumbent and Churchwardens of the Parish of Riverhead with Dunton Green in the County of Kent, ten days' previous notice of his intention in that behalf, has, under the provisions of the Burial Act 1853 as amended by subsequent enactments, made a Representation to Her Majesty in Council that burials should be discontinued forthwith in St. John's Churchyard, Dunton Green, in the said Parish, shown hatched on the plan annexed hereto.

Provided that in any earthen grave now existing in the said Churchyard that burial may be allowed of the body of

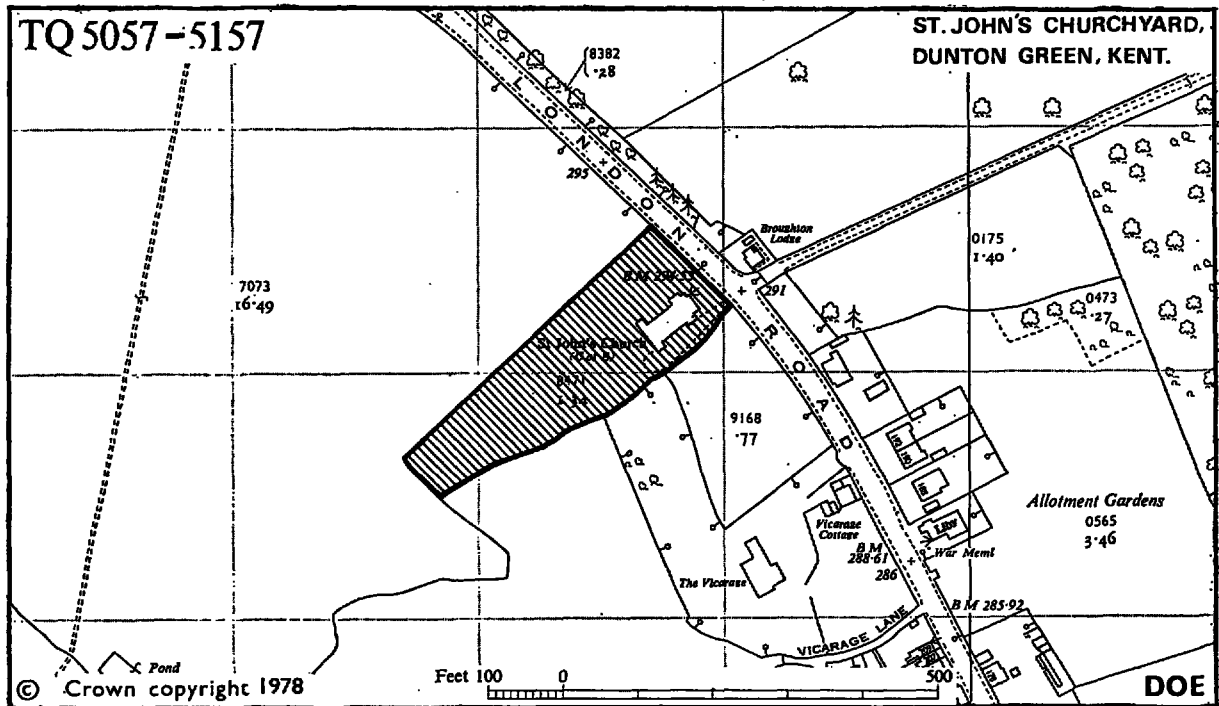
any member of the family of the person or persons heretofore buried in such grave, subject to the condition that no part of the coffin containing the body shall be at a depth less than three feet below the level of the surface of the ground adjoining the grave.

Now therefore, Her Majesty in Council is pleased hereby to give Notice of such Representation and to order that the same be taken into consideration by a Committee of the Privy Council on the 15th day of September next.

And Her Majesty is further pleased to direct that this Order be forthwith published in the *London Gazette*, and that copies thereof be affixed on the doors of the Churches or Chapels of, or on some conspicuous places within, the Parish affected by such Representation one month before the said 15th day of September.

PASTORAL MEASURE 1968

Notice is hereby given that Her Majesty was pleased on the 25th July 1978 by Order in Council to confirm the following Schemes made by the Church Commissioners for:

1. Uniting the benefices of Dunchideock and Shillingford; and Ide, and altering the name of the parish of Shillingford, in the diocese of Exeter.
2. Transferring the parish of Chatton with Chillingham to the benefice of The Wooler Group; and dissolving the benefice of Chatton with Chillingham, in the diocese of Newcastle.
3. Uniting the benefices of Harvington; and Norton and Lenchwick, in the diocese of Worcester.
4. Uniting the benefices of Peopleton; and White Ladies Aston with Spetchley and Churchill, in the diocese of Worcester.
5. Uniting the benefices of Appleton le Street with Amotherby; and Barton le Street, in the diocese of York.
6. Uniting the benefices of Waldringfield with Hemley; and Newbourn and altering the name of the parish of Newbourn, in the diocese of Saint Edmundsbury and Ipswich.
7. Appropriating part of the churchyard of the parish church of the parish of Rockbears, in the diocese of Exeter, as a site for a residence house and garden for a vicar in the Clyst Valley Team Ministry.
8. Uniting the parishes of Clayton and Keymer, in the diocese of Chichester.
9. (1) Dissolving the benefice and parish of Manchester Saint Paul, New Cross, with Saint Michael, and Saint Thomas, Redbank.

(2) Declaring redundant the parish church of the said parish and

(3) Transferring the area of the said parish to the parish of Manchester, in the diocese of Manchester.

10. Uniting the benefices of Ludgershall; and Wotton Underwood with Ashendon, in the diocese of Oxford.

11. Terminating the team ministry for the benefice of Tong, in the diocese of Bradford.

12. Uniting the benefices of Rock with Heightington; and the Holy Trinity, Bewdley Far Forest, in the diocese of Worcester.

13. Uniting the benefices of Saint Hilary; and Perranuthnoe, in the diocese of Truro.

14. Appropriating part of the churchyard of the parish church of the parish of Todwick, in the diocese of Sheffield, for any ecclesiastical purpose affecting the parish or any part thereof and vesting the said land in the Sheffield Diocesan Board of Finance.

15. Uniting the benefices and parishes of Marden; and Wisteston, in the diocese of Hereford.

16. Uniting the benefices of Elmley Lovett with Hampton Lovett; and Elmbridge with Rushock, in the diocese of Worcester.

17. Creating the new benefice and parish of Cox Green; and altering the areas of the parishes of Boyne Hill; Bray and Braywood; Saint John the Evangelist, Littlewick and Stubbings, in the diocese of Oxford.

18. Establishing a group ministry for the benefices of Barrow Gurney; Flax Bourton; Long Ashton and Wraxall, in the diocese of Bath and Wells.
