DUDLEY METROPOLITAN BOROUGH

CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

Borough of Dudley (County Borough of Dudley (Dudley Castle) Smoke Control Order 1958) Variation Order 1978.

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Dudley in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on 24th July 1978, made the above Order which is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

The effect of the Order is to vary the County Borough of Dudley (Dudley Castle) Smoke Control Order 1958 (hereinafter called "the Principal Order") so as to exclude from its operation, subject to the condition that all reasonable steps are taken to minimise smoke emissions, the buildings and fireplaces specified in the Schedule hereto.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before 1st April 1979.

Copies of the Order may be inspected free of charge at The Council House, Dudley, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from 4th August 1978.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Department of the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London, SW1P 3EB, object to the confirmation of the Order.

Those buildings and fireplaces installed as exhibits at the Black Country Museum, Tipton Road, Dudley, which if modified to comply with the requirements of section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 and of the Principal Order would lose their authenticity.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

SOUTH BEDFORDSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL

The South Bedfordshire District (Luton Road, Dunstable) (Peak-Hour Clearway) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the South Bedfordshire District Council after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police proposed to make an Order pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Bedfordshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit vehicles from waiting in Luton Road, Dunstable during peak hours on Monday to Saturday (inclusive).

When the Order comes into effect you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle in the length of Luton Road, Dunstable which extends from its junction with Poynters Road to a point 366 feet west of its junction with Ridgeway Avenue between the hours of 8 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. to 6 p.m. from Monday to Saturday inclusive.

Exceptions contained in the Order will permit waiting for a period of up to 2 minutes for the purposes of:

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers;
- (b) loading and unloading personal luggage;
- (c) opening or closing gates or barriers to premises immediately adjoining the said length of road.

Exceptions contained in the Order will also permit waiting in connection with:

- (a) the maintenance of the roads and telegraphic lines;
- (b) the supply of gas, electricity and water;
- (c) the collection and delivery of postal packets;
- (d) police, fire brigade and ambulance purposes.

Full details of the proposals are in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the restricted road and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the Administration Executive's Department, Grove House, 76 High Street North, Dunstable, Beds. between the hours of 8.45 a.m. and 4.45 p.m. Mondays to Thursdays, and 8.45 a.m. and 4.15 p.m. Fridays.

If you should wish to object to the proposed Order, you should do so in writing stating the grounds of objection to the undersigned by 31st August 1978.

When the Order comes into effect you will not be able to drive a vehicle into the boxed area at the junction of Matthew Street and West Street, Dunstable, unless your exit road is clear. You may enter the junction when you want to turn right and are prevented from doing so only by oncoming traffic.

South Bedfordshire District (Dale Road, Linden Road and Luton Road, Dunstable) (Traffic Regulation) Order, 1978

Notice is hereby given that the South Bedfordshire District Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Bedfordshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with section 84C (1) of the said Act of 1967 as so amended, propose to make this Order the effect of which will be to:
