

## GREATER LONDON COUNCIL NOTICES

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#### LONDON BOROUGH OF ISLINGTON

#### *The Islington (Prescribed Route) (No. 1) Traffic Order 1978*

Notice is hereby given that the Greater London Council on 22nd September 1978 made the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968 and the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order will be to impose one-way working for vehicular traffic in a general north-easterly direction in Lamb's Passage between Chiswell Street and Lamb's Buildings.

Exemption has been provided in the Order in respect of anything done:

- (a) with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
- (b) in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway by or on behalf of the Metropolitan Police.

A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 2nd October 1978, can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made in Room B.21, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 or on the ground that any requirement of that section of the Act or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
