

4. *Raymond Road* (Unclassified), from its junction with Albany Road/Sea View Terrace for a distance of 29 yards in an easterly direction.

5. *Albany Road* (Unclassified), from its junction with Heanton Terrace/Raymond Road for a distance of 25 yards in a south-easterly direction.

6. *Basset Street* (Unclassified):

(a) south-eastern side:

WEST GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

West Glamorgan County Council (Bridge Street, Neath) (Revocation and Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1978

Notice is hereby given that on 3rd November 1978 the West Glamorgan County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive on the undermentioned lengths of Bridge Street, Neath:

North Side

From the eastern abutment of the Canal Bridge eastwards a distance of approximately 30 metres.

South Side

From the eastern abutment of the Canal Bridge eastwards a distance of approximately 20 metres.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order for essential services, loading and unloading facilities and disabled drivers' vehicles.

This Order will come into operation on 27th November 1978 and may be cited as the "West Glamorgan County Council (Bridge Street, Neath) (Revocation and Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978".
