The County of Durham (Walkergate and Back Silver Street, Durham City) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1978.

Notice is hereby given that on 16th November 1978 the County Council of Durham made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order which will come into operation on the 20th November 1978 is to prohibit waiting by vehicles at any time on the sides of roads and length of road at Durham City in Durham District described in the Schedule to this notice.

Exemptions in the Order will permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from a vehicle;
- (c) delivery or collection of postal packets;
- (d) building operations, demolition, removal of obstructions and maintenance of the roads;
- (e) police, fire brigade and ambulance purposes;
- (f) statutory powers;
- (g) invalid carriages.
