The Trunk Road (Talgarth, Powys) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 197

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting on the sides of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice, and to restrict waiting on the side of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice to 30 minutes in any one hour between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday.
