BARROW-IN-FURNESS BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County of Cumbria (Borough of Barrow-in-Furness) (Biggar Bank Parking Places) Order, 1978

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Barrow-in-Furness has made an Order under section 31 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972. It will come into operation on 1st December 1978.

The effect of this Order is to control the use of the parking places on Biggar Bank. The maximum permitted waiting period in any case is 12 hours.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the parking places may be seen at the Town Hall, Barrow-in-Furness, Monday to Friday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

If you wish to question the validity of this Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may then, within 6 weeks from 1st December 1978, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

BERKSHIRE ROYAL COUNTY COUNCIL

Royal County of Berkshire (Forest Road (B.3034) and Terrace Road, Binfield) (Prohibition of Waiting) and (Bus Stops) (Clearway) Order 1978.

Notice is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council have made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 the effect of which is to:

1. Prohibit waiting at any time on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice.
2. Prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

Exemptions to the above mentioned prohibitions for disabled drivers, loading and unloading, etc., have been included in the Order:

3. Prohibit vehicles, other than buses from waiting between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on any day at any bus stop in the Forest Road, where the bus stop is marked
 - (a) as a bus stop, and
 - (b) with a broad yellow line adjacent to the edge of the carriageway ("the authorised markings").

Although this part of the Order refers to every bus stop in Forest Road it should be noted that the provisions of the Order which prohibits waiting will apply only to those bus stops which the Council marks with the authorised markings.

While the Order remains in force it enables the Council at any time to lay or to remove the authorised markings at or from any bus stop in Forest Road or to adjust the position in that road of the authorised markings as traffic conditions may require.

Other vehicles will be permitted to wait at bus stops with authorised markings where necessary:

- (a) for the removal of obstruction to traffic;
- (b) in certain circumstances in exercise of statutory powers;

(c) in certain emergencies; and

(d) for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

The Order will come into operation on 4th December 1978.

Copies of the Order and relevant map can be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of the Bracknell District Council and at the County Surveyor's Office, Traffic Management Section, First Floor, Kennet House, Kings Road, Reading.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended as aforesaid or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 27th November 1978 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

No Waiting

1. *Forest Road* (B.3034), north side, from its junction with Terrace Road, westwards, for a distance of approximately 69 metres.
2. *Forest Road* (B.3034), north side, from its junction with Terrace Road, eastwards, to a point 17 metres east of that junction.
3. *Forest Road* (B.3034), south side, from its junction with Terrace Road, westwards for a distance of approximately 50 metres.
4. *Forest Road* (B.3034), south side, from its junction with Terrace Road, eastwards, for a distance of approximately 125 metres.
5. *Terrace Road*, west side, from its junction with Forest Road (B.3034), northwards, for a distance of approximately 20 metres.
6. *Terrace Road*, west side, from its junction with Forest Road (B.3034), southwards, to a point approximately 97 metres south of that junction.
7. *Terrace Road*, east side, from its junction with Forest Road (B.3034), northwards, for a distance of approximately 45 metres.
8. *Terrace Road*, east side, from its junction with Forest Road (B.3034), southwards, for a distance of approximately 60 metres.

BERKSHIRE ROYAL COUNTY COUNCIL

Royal County of Berkshire (A.3095, Between Twin Bridges Roundabout and Western Roundabout, Bracknell) (Temporary Prohibition of Right Hand Turn) Order 1978.

Notice is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council have made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle proceeding north-eastwards in that length of the A.3095 which lies between Twin Bridges Roundabout and Western Roundabout from making a right-hand turn into the slip road which leads to Skimped Hill Lane.
