SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL

1. *The County of Somerset (Road at Charlton Mackrell) (Weight Restriction) Order, 1978*
2. *The County of Somerset (Queen Street, Keinton Mandeville) (Weight Restriction) Order, 1978*

Notice is hereby given that on 24th November 1978, the Somerset County Council made the above-named Orders under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended. The effect of the Orders is to prohibit the driving of any vehicle the weight of which, whether laden or unladen, exceeds three tons in the following lengths of road:

- (1) the Class III road in the Parish of Charlton Mackrell which extends from the junction with Route B.3153 at Christians Cross southwards through Charlton Mackrell to the junction with Route A.372; and
- (2) *Queen Street, Keinton Mandeville*, whole length.

Exemptions are provided in the Orders for access to premises, and in connection with building operations, the removal of obstructions to traffic, maintenance of the roads or services therein or by emergency vehicles. The Order relating to *Queen Street, Keinton Mandeville* also includes an exemption for vehicles *bona fide* travelling to or from Lake View Quarry.

The Orders will come into operation on 4th December 1978.

Copies of the Orders together with maps showing the roads affected may be inspected at the offices of Yeovil District Council, 91 Preston Road, Yeovil, or at County Hall, Taunton, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of either of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL

The City of Southampton (Park Road/Richmond Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that Southampton City Council made the above Order on 28th November 1978 pursuant

to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council and in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

The effect of this Order which comes into operation on 4th December 1978 will be to prohibit waiting at any time in the following lengths of road:

1. For a distance of 15 metres on both sides of Cawte Road at its junction with Park Road.
2. For a distance of 15 metres on both sides of Firgrove Road at its junction with Park Road and Richmond Road.
3. For a distance of 15 metres on both sides of Pitt Road at its junction with Park Road.
4. On both sides of Park Road and Richmond Road, from a point 15 metres south-west of the south-western kerbline of Firgrove Road to a point 15 metres east of the eastern kerbline of Cawte Road.

A copy of the Order and a plan showing the effect of the Order may be inspected in Room 18 of my Office during normal working hours.

If you wish to question the validity of this Order or of any of the provisions contained in it on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, or on the grounds that any of the requirements of that Act or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from 28th November 1978 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

STAFFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Stafford (Burton Square, Stafford) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 5th December 1978 make application to the High Court.
