## SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL

### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967 (AS AMENDED)

#### *Surrey County Council (South Street) Dorking (Prohibition of Waiting) Amendment Order 1979*

Notice is hereby given that the Surrey County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in that length of South Street, Dorking, on the north-western side from the termination of the existing "No Waiting At Any Time" restriction at a point 99.06 metres north-east of its junction with Junction Road to a point opposite the boundary between the properties Numbers 26 and 28 South Street, a distance of approximately 12 metres.

The usual exemptions for loading and unloading vehicles, boarding and alighting from vehicles, for work on or adjoining that length of side of road, the maintenance of the road and the services therein, and for disabled persons' vehicles in accordance with the Orange Badge scheme will be included in the proposed Order.

A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the road to which the Order relates and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined free of charge at the County Deeds Office (Room 119), County Hall, Kingston-upon-Thames (Mondays to Fridays 10 a.m.—5 p.m.) and the Mole Valley District Council Offices, Pippbrook, Dorking (9 a.m.—5 p.m.).

## WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

#### *The County Council of West Sussex (Southwick: The Twitten and Whiterock Place) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1978.*

Notice is hereby given that on 29th November 1978, the West Sussex County Council made an Order under the provisions of section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974 the effect of which is to prohibit waiting at all times in the following short lengths of road in Southwick:

#### *The Twitten*

##### North side

(i) from Southwick Street westwards for 14 metres (15 yards);

(ii) from The Green eastwards for 37 metres (41 yards);

##### South side

(i) from Southwick Street westwards for 14 metres (15 yards);

(ii) from The Green eastwards for 14 metres (15 yards);

#### *Whiterock Place*

##### South side

(i) from a point 14 metres (15 yards) east of Station Road eastwards for 21 metres (23 yards);

(ii) from a point 69 metres east of Station Road eastwards for 11 metres (12 yards).

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable vehicles to stop and pick up and set down passengers, goods or merchandise, to wait when engaged in building operations or the repair of the roads or the services therein, or to take in petrol, oil, air or water from a garage, and in connection with funerals or weddings.

Invalid carriage and disabled persons' vehicles displaying in the relevant position disabled persons' badges and a parking disc issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations, 1975, will be able to wait in the lengths of road above for up to 2 hours, their return prohibited within 1 hour.

A copy of the Order which will come into operation on 6th December 1978, and a map showing the lengths of road to which the Order relates may be inspected at the County Hall, Chichester, during normal office hours.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks from 6th December 1978, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

## THANET DISTRICT COUNCIL

#### *The Thanet District Council (The Borough of Margate (Various Roads) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulation) Order 1970) (Variation) (No. 3) Order 1978.* *Fort Hill, Margate, Extension of "No Waiting" Restriction*

Notice is hereby given that the Thanet District Council, in the exercise of powers delegated to it by the Kent County Council, the highway authority, made an Order on 24th November 1978 under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974. It will come into operation on 4th December 1978.

The effect of this Order is that you are not allowed, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the side of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice between the hours of 8 a.m. and midnight on any day. (N.B. Formerly, waiting was not permitted between the said hours from 15th May to 15th September in any year.)

Exceptions will permit the following:

(1) waiting for so long as may be necessary:

- (a) for persons to board or alight;
- (b) for enabling works to be carried out;
- (c) in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; and
- (d) for the loading or unloading of goods; and

(2) the waiting of disabled persons' vehicles.
