

Schedule to this notice in the direction specified in relation thereto in column 2 of the said Schedule ;

- (b) to prohibit vehicular traffic proceeding in the carriageway comprising the roundabout to be constructed at or adjacent to the junction of Woolwich Road and Blackwall Tunnel southern approach from entering the carriageway on the north-east side of the island site lying immediately north-west of the said roundabout ;
- (c) to prohibit the right turn by vehicular traffic from Woolwich Road into Halstow Road ;
- (d) to prohibit any vehicle proceeding in Woolwich Road from entering the gaps in the central reservation situated opposite its junction with Combedale Road ;
- (e) to compel the left turn by vehicular traffic from Tunnel Avenue into Woolwich Road ;
- (f) to compel the left turn by vehicular traffic from Combedale Road into Woolwich Road.

3. The prohibition and requirement referred to in paragraph 2 (d) and (e) above would not apply to a vehicle being used for fire brigade purposes in an emergency.

4. The prohibitions and requirements referred to in paragraph 2 (a) to (f) (inclusive) above would not apply in respect of anything done:

- (a) with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform ;
- (b) in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway by or on behalf of the Metropolitan Police.

5. A copy of the proposed Order, of the Greenwich (Prescribed Routes) Traffic Order 1969 (which originally imposed a system of traffic control in the vicinity of the Woolwich Road flyover and which would be amended) and of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until 22nd February 1979, in Room B.21, The County Hall, London, SE1 7PB.
