*The Islington (Parking Places) (No. ) Order 197 (Proposed Amendments to Controlled Parking Zone No. 5)*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Islington is applying to the Greater London Council for an Order to be titled the Islington (Parking Places) (No. ) Order 197 under sections 35, 36, 37, 40 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

The general effect of the Order would be:

- to revoke the designation by the Islington (Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 1976 of the metred 4-hour parking place numbered 61 in Canonbury Villas;
- to designate a metred 4-hour parking place on the west side of Halton Road 7.10 metres south of Hawes Street;
- to provide that the parking place would operate between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and between 8.30 a.m. and 1.30 p.m. on Saturdays (Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays excepted);

(d) to specified that:

(i) the vehicles which may be left in the metred parking place shall be passenger vehicles (12 seats or less), goods carrying vehicles, motor cycles and invalid carriages; and

(ii) the initial charge would be at the rate of 10p for 40 minutes (maximum initial period 4 hours); the excess charge—payable to this Council—would be £3; the excess charge period would be 1 hour; the unexpired time shown on the parking meter may be used free of charge and the period during which vehicles may not return to the parking place would be 1 hour;

(N.B. On 28th April 1978 application was made to the G.L.C. to increase parking charges in this Zone. If it is approved the rate at this 4-hour parking place would become 10p for 30 minutes and the excess charge—payable to this Council—£4.)
