

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of West Sussex (Littlehampton: Various Roads) (Control of Dogs on Roads) Order, 1979.

Notice is hereby given that on 31st January 1979, the West Sussex County Council made an Order under the provisions of section 31 of the Road Traffic Act, 1972, the effect of which is to make it an offence for any person to cause or permit a dog to be on the following roads and lengths of road in Littlehampton without the dog being held on a lead:

Coastguard Road
Windmill Road
Arun Parade
South Terrace between Pier Road and St. Catherine's Road
Pier Road
Clifton Road
New Road
Bayford Road between Arcade Road and New Road
Arcade Road
Surrey Street
River Road
Hampton Court
Terminus Road
Terminus Place
Purbeck Place
Ferry Road between Terminus Road and Rope Walk
Rope Walk
Bridge Road between Terminus Road and the bridge over the river Arun and Wharf Road.

A copy of the Order which will come into operation on 7th February 1979, together with a plan showing the affected roads may be inspected at the County Hall, Chichester during normal office hours.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Act, 1972 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks from 7th February 1979, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of West Sussex (Littlehampton: High Street (Part)) (Revocation of One-Way Traffic) Order, 1979.

The County Council of West Sussex (Littlehampton: St. Martins Service Road) (Prohibition of Driving and One-Way Traffic) Order, 1979.

Notice is hereby given that the West Sussex County Council propose to make Orders under the provisions of sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974 the effects of which will be as follows:

1. to revoke the existing one-way traffic Order in respect of that length of the High Street, Littlehampton, from its junction with East Street to its junction with Beach Road insofar as it relates to buses only;
2. to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in St. Martins Service Road, Littlehampton, from its junction with Arundel Road to its junction with St. Martins Rear Service Area; and
3. to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in a direction other than eastwards in the length of road described above.

An exception will be contained in the Order in respect of 2 above to enable buses to proceed in an easterly direction along the road.

Copies of the draft Orders, plans showing the affected lengths of road and statements of the County Council's

reasons for proposing to make the Orders may be inspected at the County Hall, Chichester, during normal office hours and at the Public Library, Maltravers Road, Littlehampton, during normal library opening hours. Library staff will not be in a position to answer questions on the proposals and any enquiries should be addressed to the undersigned.

Objections to the proposals together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 23rd February 1979.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of West Sussex (Warningcamp: Youth Hostel Road) (Prohibition of Use of Highway by Public Service Vehicles) Order, 1979.

Notice is hereby given that the West Sussex County Council propose to make an Order under the provisions of section 15 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972, after consultation with the Traffic Commissioners and with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport the effect of which will be to prohibit any contract carriage (which is a public service vehicle not carrying passengers at separate fares) from proceeding in that length of Youth Hostel Road in the Parish of Warningcamp from a point 30 metres west of Burpham Road at Warningcamp Cross-roads westwards for 265 metres.

A copy of the draft Order, a plan showing the lengths of road affected by the proposal together with a statement of the County Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the County Hall, Chichester, during normal office hours and at the Public Library, Surrey Street, Arundel, during normal library opening hours. Library staff will not be in a position to answer questions on the proposal and any enquiries should be addressed to the undersigned.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of West Sussex (Fernhurst: Haslemere Road (A.286) and Church Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1979.

Notice is hereby given that the West Sussex County Council propose to make an Order under the provisions of sections 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from waiting at any time in the following lengths of road in the Parish of Fernhurst:

Haslemere Road (A.286), both sides, from Vann Road northwards for 131 metres; and
Church Road, north side, from Haslemere Road (A.286) eastwards for 93 metres.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable vehicles (i) to stop and pick up and set down passengers, goods or merchandise, (ii) to wait when engaged in building operations or the repair of the road or the services therein; (iii) to take in petrol, oil, air or water from a garage and (iv) to wait in connection with weddings and funerals. Invalid carriages displaying in the relevant position a disabled persons badge issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations, 1975, and a parking disc will be permitted to wait in the lengths of road for periods of up to 2 hours, their return being prohibited within 1 hour.
