6. *Non-Continuous Service Personnel and Careers Advisory Service*

Non-Continuous Service personnel and members of the Careers Advisory Service shall receive the appropriate rate of pay on the Intermediate scale (Six Years but less than Nine Years) as for regular ratings and other ranks. The pay classification for ratings is as in paragraph 1 (a) and for other ranks as in paragraph 4 (a).

SCHEDULE 4

LONDON PAY

1. London Pay may be awarded in accordance with the regulations laid down by the Admiralty Board to regular Royal Navy and Royal Marine personnel (up to and including Captain Royal Navy and equivalent with effect from 1st April 1974 and up to Rear Admiral and equivalent with effect from 1st June 1975) who are drafted, attached, or appointed for duty at establishments in the London area.

2. London Pay is an additional taxable emolument intended to ensure broad comparability of real earnings between those personnel who work in London and those who work elsewhere. The rates determined from time
