DYFED COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Dyfed (Slip Road at Sardis Cross near Haverfordwest) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 7th February 1979, the Dyfed County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in the length of road specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in column 2 of the said Schedule.

The Order will come into operation on 15th February 1979, and a copy of the order, together with a map showing the length of road affected, may be inspected at the offices of the Dyfed County Council, County Hall, Carmarthen, during the normal office hours.

West Glamorgan County Council (New Road, Skewen) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 2nd February 1979 West Glamorgan County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 the effect of which is to prohibit waiting between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. from Monday to Saturday on the undermentioned length of New Road:

South side, from a point 92 metres east of the eastern kerbline of Stanley Road to a point 140 metres west of the western kerbline of Stanley Road.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order for essential services, loading and unloading facilities and disabled drivers' vehicles.

WEST GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

The West Glamorgan County Council (Bond Street, Swansea) (Prohibition of Entry) Order 1979
