

When this Order comes into effect on 12th February 1979 you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle on the following lengths of road at Crich:

*No waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.
Monday—Saturday inclusive*

The Common, both sides, from a point approximately 30 metres (33 yards) south of its junction with Dimple Lane in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 80 metres (87 yards).

Dimple Lane

west side, from its junction with The Common for a distance of approximately 30 metres (33 yards).

east side, from its junction with The Common for a distance of approximately 40 metres (44 yards).

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from 8th February 1979 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Coffinswell Lane, Kingskerswell) (Prohibition of Waiting) (No. 2) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 30th January 1979, the Devon County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

When the Order comes into effect on 12th February 1979, you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle at any time in the following lengths of road:

Coffinswell Lane

North side, from its junction with Newton Road (A.380) to its junction with Princess Road.

South side, from its junction with Newton Road (A.380) to a point 77 metres (84 yards) east of that junction.

Exemptions in the Order permit waiting for the purpose of boarding and alighting, loading or unloading, Post Office services, maintenance of the road, supply of gas, water and electricity, pursuance of statutory powers or duties, taking in petrol, oil or air from a garage. The statutory exemptions for disabled persons' vehicles are included.
