The Greater Manchester County (Various Streets, Tameside) (Half Box Junctions) (County) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that on 1st February 1979, the Greater Manchester County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit the driving of a vehicle into any of the areas of carriageway defined by diagonal yellow lines and known as "boxed areas" at the following junctions:

Ashton Road, Dukinfield, eastern side of the centre line of the carriageway at Cheetham Hill Road.

Ashton Road, Hyde, eastern side, of the centre line of the carriageway at Gregory Street.

Stockport Road, Denton, western side, of the centre line of the carriageway at Victoria Street.

and thereafter to drive such vehicle in such a direction that it becomes necessary, owing to the presence of stationary vehicles, for any part of the vehicle to remain at rest in the boxed area.

Nothing in the Order applies to vehicles used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes or to vehicles waiting to make a right turn which is not prohibited.

The Greater Manchester County (Peel Lane, Madams Wood Road, Jonquil Drive and Aspinall Crescent, Worsley) (Prohibition of Waiting) (County) Order 1978.

Notice is hereby given that on 1st February 1979 the Greater Manchester County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting at any time on the following lengths of streets:

Peel Lane, south-east side—from a point 15 metres north of Madams Wood Road in a southerly direction to a point 15 metres south of Madams Wood Road.

Madams Wood Road, north-easterly side from Peel Lane in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 44 metres. North-easterly and northerly side—from a point 62 metres south-east of Peel Lane to a point 10 metres east of Aspinall Crescent.

South-westerly and southerly side—from Peel Lane to a point 10 metres east of Aspinall Crescent.

Jonquil Drive, both sides from Madams Wood Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 10 metres.

Aspinall Crescent, both sides, from Madams Wood Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 10 metres.

The Order contains exemptions to permit waiting for the purpose of boarding or alighting, loading and unloading, funerals, building operations and work on or under the lengths of road. Disabled persons' vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and parking disc may wait for up to two hours return prohibited within one hour.

A copy of the Order which comes into operation on 19th February 1979 and a map showing the roads to which it relates, may be inspected between 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays at the County Secretary's Office, County Hall (Minshull Street entrance), Piccadilly Gardens, Manchester and the Common Law Section, Salford City Council, 214 Chorley Road, Swinton.

The Greater Manchester County (Hope Street, Wigan) (Restriction of Waiting) (No. 2) (County) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that on 1st February 1979 the Greater Manchester County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting between 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on the following length of street:

Hope Street, east side from the junction with Marsden Street to its junction with Mesnes Terrace.
