

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended. The Orders and their effect will be:

The Greater Manchester County (Boothstown Bridge, Boothstown) (Weight Restriction) (County) Order 1978.

To prohibit the use of so much of Moss House Lane as is carried by Boothstown Bridge, over the Bridgewater Canal at Boothstown, Worsley, to vehicles the weight of which whether laden or unladen exceeds 20 tons.

The Greater Manchester County (Vicars Hall Bridge, Boothstown) (Weight Restriction) (County) Order 1978.

To prohibit the use of so much of Vicars Hall Lane, Boothstown, as is carried by Vicars Hall Bridge, over the Bridgewater Canal at Boothstown, Worsley, to vehicles any axle weight of which whether laden or unladen exceeds 6 tons.

GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

The Greater Manchester County (Oldham Road/Townley Street and Associated Side Streets, Middleton) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (County) Order 1978.

Notice is hereby given that the Greater Manchester County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be:

- (a) to prohibit waiting at all times and to prohibit loading/unloading on Mondays to Fridays between 7.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and 4 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on:

Oldham Road (A669), north side, from a point 87 metres west of Townley Street to a point 50 metres east of Townley Street.

Oldham Road, south side, from a point 87 metres west of Townley Street to a point 96 metres east of Townley Street.

Townley Street (B6189), west side, from Victoria Street to Adelaide Street.

Townley Street, east side, from Victoria Street to Spring Vale.

Spring Vale, south side, from Townley Street to a point 15 metres east of Townley Street.

Preston Street, both sides, from Townley Street to a point 15 metres east of Townley Street.

Albert Street, both sides, from Townley Street to a point 15 metres west of Townley Street.

Victoria Street, north side, from Townley Street to a point 15 metres west of Townley Street.

- (b) to prohibit waiting on Mondays to Fridays between 7.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and 4 p.m. and 6.30 p.m., on:

Oldham Road, north side, from a point 50 metres east of Townley Street to Hanson Street.

- (c) to prohibit waiting on Mondays to Saturdays between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on:

Adelaide Street, south side, entire length.

Sharp Street, south side, entire length.

Preston Street, north side, from a point 15 metres east of Townley Street to Hanson Street.

Preston Street, south side, from a point 15 metres east of Townley Street for 50 metres further east.

The proposed Order will contain exemptions to permit waiting for the purposes of boarding or alighting, loading or unloading (except when prohibited), funerals, building operations, or work on or under the lengths of road. Disabled persons' vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc will be allowed to wait for up to 2 hours, return prohibited within 1 hour, except when a loading ban is in operation.
