

SALOP COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of Salop (School Ground Lane, Newport) (Traffic Regulation) Order 19

Notice is hereby given that the Salop County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

When this Order comes into effect:

- (a) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the road specified in column 1 of the Schedule of this notice in a direction other than specified in relation to that road in column 2 of that Schedule, and
- (b) No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed from Stafford Road to Meadow Road along the road specified in column 1 of the Schedule of this notice.

Full details of the proposals are in the draft Order, which, together with the relevant plan and a statement of the County Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order

may be examined during the normal office hours at The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury, and during normal opening hours at the Branch Library, High Street, Newport. SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Somerset (Slip Road at Killing's Knap, Stratton-on-the-Fosse) (Prohibition of Entry) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 2nd February 1979 the Somerset County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle which is proceeding in the Midsomer Norton to Stratton-on-the-Fosse Road (Route B.3355) at Killing's Knap in the Parish of Stratton-on-the-Fosse in the District of Mendip from entering the Slip Road which lies to the west of the island at the junction of Route B.3355 with the Bath to Oakhill Road (Route A.367).

The Order will come into operation on 10th February 1979.

A copy of the Order and a plan showing the roads affected may be inspected by members of the public free of charge at County Hall, Taunton or at the Post Office, Stratton-on-the-Fosse during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
