BOURNEMOUTH BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Bournemouth (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1975 (Variation) (No. 58) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that the Bournemouth Borough Council, acting as agent of the Dorset County Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the said County Council propose to make an Order under Sections 1(1), (2) and (3) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

When this Order comes into effect waiting will be prohibited on Holdenhurst Road:-

- (i) at any time with exemption for Hackney Carriages on the north-western side from a point 86 metres (283 feet) south-west of its junction with St. Paul's Road for a distance of 22 metres (72 feet) in a south-westerly direction.
- (ii) at any time from a point 108 metres (355 feet) south-west of its junction with St. Paul's Road for a distance of 33 metres (108 feet) in a south-westerly direction.
- (iii) to one hour in any hour between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. from a point 165 metres (540 feet) south-west of its junction with St. Paul's Road for a distance of 22 metres (72 feet) in a south-westerly direction.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:-

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers,
(b) loading and unloading goods,

and, where necessary, in connection with:-

- (c) the maintenance of the roads, and
(d) the supply of gas, electricity and water.

BOURNEMOUTH BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Bournemouth (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1975 (Variation) (No. 75) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that the Bournemouth Borough Council, acting as agent of the Dorset County Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the said County Council, propose to make an Order under Sections 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

When this Order comes into effect:-

(a) Christchurch Road

- (i) Waiting will be prohibited at any time on the north-western side from a point 32 metres (105 feet) north-east of its junction with Waltham Road in a north-easterly direction to cover the south-western end of the lay-by fronting 1102-1114 Christchurch Road.
- (ii) Waiting will be prohibited at any time on the north-eastern side of the lay-by fronting 1102-1114 Christchurch Road to its junction with Holdenhurst Avenue.
- (iii) Waiting will be limited to $\frac{1}{2}$ hour in any hour between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. on the lay-by fronting 1102-1114 Christchurch Road.

(b) Hambledon Road

Waiting will be prohibited at any time on both sides from its junction with Holdenhurst Avenue for a distance of 9 metres (30 feet) in a north-westerly direction.

(c) Holdenhurst Avenue

Waiting will be prohibited at any time on both sides from its junction with Christchurch Road in a north-easterly direction to a point 9 metres (30 feet) north-east of its junction with Hambledon Road including the lay-by fronting the closed section of Hambledon Road.

(d) Charminster Road

Waiting will be prohibited between 7 p.m. and 4 a.m. with exemption for Hackney Carriages on the north-western side from a point 19 metres (63 feet) north-east of its junction with Shelbourne Road for a distance of 22 metres (72 feet) in a south-westerly direction.

(e) Columbia Road

Waiting will be prohibited at any time on the southern side from a point opposite the western boundary of Number 183 Columbia Road in a westerly direction to its junction with Talbot Rise.

(f) Francis Avenue Cul-de-sac Section Adjacent to Ringwood Road

- (i) Waiting will be prohibited at any time on the north-eastern side from its junction with the main arm of Francis Avenue for a distance of 43 metres (140 feet) in an easterly direction.
- (ii) Waiting will be prohibited at any time from its south-eastern extremity for a distance of 9 metres (30 feet) in a north-westerly direction.
