The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Off-Street Parking Places) (Solihull) (Amendment) (No.2) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that the Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council with the consent of the West Midlands County Council on 9th February 1979 made the above-mentioned Order under Section 31 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, to vary the scale of charges for the Link Road, Civic Hall and George Road parking places as follows:—

1. That an Excess Charge of £1 be introduced for parking up to one hour in excess of the parking period purchased;
2. That a £3 excess charge be introduced for parking up to two hours in excess of the parking period purchased and over one hour; and
3. That a £6 excess charge be imposed for overstaying by two hours or more or for failure to purchase a ticket.

The remainder of the charges will not be varied. The Order effective on 12th February 1979 and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, may be inspected at the Council House, Solihull, during normal office hours.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order, may within 6 weeks from 9th February 1979 apply to the High Court for that purpose.—Dated 10th February 1979.
