SCHEDULE

The Avenue, both sides of that length of the county classified road No. C.37 known as The Avenue which extends for a distance of 36 metres from its junction with Maendu Street to a point 14 metres south-east of its junction with Mill Street.

Cradoc Road, both sides of that length of the county classified road No. C.37 known as Cradoc Road which extends for a distance of 54.5 metres from a point where the said C.37 becomes known as The Avenue to a point 30 metres north-west of the junction of Cradoc Road with Maendu Street.

Maendu Street

(i) Both sides of that length of the county unclassified road No. 722 known as Maendu Street which extends from its junction with The Avenue to a point 30 metres north-east of that junction.

(ii) Both sides of that length of Maendu Street which extends from its junction with Cradoc Road to a point 30 metres north-east of that junction.

Mill Street, both sides of that length of the county unclassified road No. 715 known as Mill Street which extends from its junction with The Avenue to a point 30 metres south-west of that junction. (782)

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The London Borough of Redbridge (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Amendment No. 4) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that in exercise of powers delegated by the Greater London Council the Council of the London Borough of Redbridge has made an Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 to amend the Redbridge (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) Order 1978 which consolidates all previous Orders imposing restrictions on vehicles, with certain exceptions, with regard to waiting, the offer or exposure for sale of goods from vehicles and on advertising activities in certain streets in the London Borough of Redbridge.

The effect of the proposed Order, which was made on 8th February 1979 and came into operation on 12th February 1979, is to extend these restrictions such that waiting in Highbury Gardens, Seven Kings, between its junction with High Road, Ilford, and High Road, Seven Kings and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 2 and 4 Highbury Gardens, is prohibited from Monday to Saturday, 8 a.m. until 6.30 p.m. This restriction does not apply to the service road at the rear of Nos. 514-570 High Road, Seven Kings.

Copies of the London Borough of Redbridge (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) Order 1978, the Order, and a copy of the Council's statement of reasons may be inspected during normal office hours for a period of 6 weeks from the date on which this Order was made at the Information Centre, Town Hall, High Road, Ilford, Essex.

Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 or on the ground that any requirement of those sections or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of that Act or of any Regulations made under the said section 84C have not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within the above-mentioned

period of 6 weeks, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of West Sussex (Walberton : Dairy Lane) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1979

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

West Sussex County Council (Billingshurst : Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that the West Sussex County Council propose to make an Order under the provisions of section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and by Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be:

1. To prohibit vehicles from waiting at any time in lengths of the following roads in Billingshurst:

Brookers Road, Daux Road (Lower Station Road end), Lower Station Road, Silver Lane (Station Road end), Station Road (between Silver Lane and level crossing), Access Road to the Railway Station Car Park;

2. To prohibit vehicles from waiting between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays to Fridays, in lengths of the following roads in Billingshurst:

Brookers Road, south side, Lower Station Road, Station Road;

3. To limit waiting to one hour return prohibited within one hour between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays in the following roads in Billingshurst:

Lower Station Road, Station Road.

Exceptions will be provided to 1, 2 and 3 above to enable vehicles:

(a) to stop and pick up and set down passengers, goods or merchandise;

(b) to wait whilst engaged in building operations or the repair of the roads or the services therein, or for the removal of any obstruction to traffic;

(c) to wait whilst in the service of a Local Authority or Water Authority;

(d) to wait for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets;

(e) to take in petrol, oil, air or water from a garage;

(f) to wait in connection with any wedding or funeral;

(g) to wait whilst being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;

(h) to wait upon an authorised parking place, or being a hackney carriage, to wait upon an authorised cab rank.
