

Regulation Act 1967 would, if made, have the effect of revoking and re-enacting, with additions, the Trunk Road (High Street, Brownhills) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 1969. The additions are:

- (i) to extend the existing no waiting at any time and no loading or unloading 7.30 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 6.30 p.m. restrictions on the south-west side of High Street from its junction with Pelsall Road, to its junction with Lichfield Road, a distance of 93 yards; and
- (ii) to extend the existing limited waiting restrictions on the north-east side of High Street from its junction with Pelsall Road to its junction with Brickiln Street, a distance of 563 yards, to no waiting at any time and no loading or unloading 7.30 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 6.30 p.m.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle except between the times specified above, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein. Disabled persons will be exempt from the waiting restrictions for periods up to two hours except when there is a ban on loading and unloading.

Copies of the above mentioned draft Order, the Order to be revoked, together with a plan illustrating the proposals and a statement of reasons have been deposited and may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of Walsall Metropolitan Borough Council, Civic Centre, Walsall, West Midlands or obtained by application to the Regional Controller, Roads and Transportation, West Midland Regional Office, Departments of the Environment and Transport, Five Ways House, Islington Row Middleway, Birmingham B15 1SL.

Objectors are reminded that the substance of their objections or representations may be communicated to other people who may be affected by them; that they will be passed to the Inspector holding the Inquiry; and that in that event the Inspector may be required to disclose the objections or representations at the Inquiry and unless there are special reasons to the contrary, the identity of the authors.

### SECTION 9(6) OF THE LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1976

#### *Anglian Water Authority*

An application having been received from the Anglian Water Authority for the variation of the main river map of their area, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in pursuance of section 9 (6) of the Land Drainage Act 1976, hereby gives notice of his intention to vary the said main river map in accordance with the proposals described below.

The effect of the proposals will be to confer on the Anglian Water Authority alone the power to exercise certain land drainage functions (including maintenance) in relation to the added watercourses.

#### *Additions*

- (1) Part of East Marsh Drain, within the parish of Goxhill, Glanford Borough, Humberside.
- (2) Part of Skinnand Dike, within the parish of Navenby, North Kesteven District, Lincolnshire.
- (3) Part of Cardinal Dike, within the parish of Navenby, North Kesteven District, Lincolnshire.
