SALMON AND FRESHWATER FISHERIES ACT 1975

Fishery Byelaws

Notice is hereby given that the Northumbrian Water Authority intend to apply to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, not less than one month after the date of publication of this Notice, for confirmation of Byelaws made by the Authority the effect of which is to define the type and method of operation of nets which may be used for fishing for salmon and migratory trout within the area of the Authority.

During the period of one month from the date of publication of this Notice a printed copy of the said Byelaws will be deposited at the offices of the Authority (Northumbria House, Regent Centre, Gosforth, Newcastle-upon-Tyne NE3 3PX), and will be open to public inspection, without charges on any weekday other than Saturday during normal office hours.

During the same period, printed copies of the Byelaws will be supplied on demand free of charge to any person appearing to the Authority to be interested.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR AN ABSTRACTION LICENCE AT QUEEN COURT FARM, FAVERSHAM

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to Southern Water Authority by Shepherd Neame Limited, Queen Court Farm, Ospringe, Faversham, Kent, to abstract water from a borehole on Queen Court Farm, map reference TQ 0064: two million gallons per year, 96,000 gallons per day.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Severn Trent Water Authority by P. Palmer & Son of Manor Farm, Rearsby, Leicester, for a licence to abstract the following quantities of water from the underground strata (disused sand quarry), in the parish of Rearsby at the following point of abstraction: 54.5 cubic metres per hour, 654.6 cubic metres per day, 10,000 cubic metres per year at NGR SK 641 139.

The water will be used for spray irrigation during the period April to September inclusive.
