HUMBERSIDE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Humberside (Borough of North Wolds) (Various Streets, Market Weighton) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1979.

Notice is hereby given that the Humberside County Council propose to make a Road Traffic Regulation Order the effect of which will be that no person shall cause any vehicle to wait at any time in parts of Finkle Street, Holme Road, Linegate, Londesborough Road and Southgate, Market Weighton.

Exemptions will include permission to wait for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading, the maintenance of roads, gas, water and electricity supplies.

ISLWYN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Islwyn (Channel View, Risca) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 14th February 1979 the Islwyn Borough Council made the above-named Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

This Order comes into effect on 9th March 1979, and you will not be permitted to leave your vehicle at any time in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule below.

There are exceptions in the Order to enable:

- (i) a person to board or alight from a vehicle;
- (ii) a vehicle to be used for building, industrial or demolition operations;
- (iii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (iv) maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road;
- (v) laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the said road, of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line;
- (vi) delivery or collection of postal packets;
- (vii) vehicle to take in oil, air, petrol or water from an adjacent garage;
- (viii) vehicle to be used in connection with a wedding or funeral;
- (ix) vehicle used in connection with fire, ambulance or police purposes;
- (x) loading and unloading of goods to and from vehicles;
- (xi) vehicle to wait upon an authorised parking place;
- (xii) a hackney carriage to wait upon an authorised cab rank;
- (xiii) disabled drivers to park for the regulation period.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers enforced by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may, within six weeks from the date hereof apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Lengths of road in Risca in the Borough of Islwyn

Channel View, both sides, from a point 242 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Lower Wyndham Terrace for a distance of 76 metres in a south-easterly direction.

Cul-de-sac leading to Nos. 1-76 Channel View

North-west side, from the northern kerb-line of Channel View for a distance of 20 metres.

South-east side, from the northern kerb-line of Channel view for a distance of 15 metres. (766)

ISLWYN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Islwyn (Fern Lea Link Road, Risca) (Prohibition of Commercial Vehicles of Over 3 Tons) Order 1979.

Notice is hereby given that on 14th February 1979 the Islwyn Borough Council made the above-named Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

This Order comes into effect on 9th March 1979, and the effect of which is to prohibit commercial vehicles, the unladen weight of which exceeds 3 tons, from proceeding from a point 20 metres west of the western kerb-line of Mount Road, Risca, for a distance of 86 metres in a north-westerly direction.

There are exemptions in the Order:

- (i) to allow emergency vehicles (police, fire or ambulance) access to land or premises on or adjacent to the said length of road;
- (ii) in connection with military operations;
- (iii) in connection with road works, laying pipes, water, gas, electricity mains, telegraph lines, collection of refuse etc.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the prohibition are available at the Civic Centre, Room 320, Blackwood Road, Pontllanfraith, where they may be examined during normal office hours and at Risca Post Office, 64 Tredegar Street, Risca, during usual opening hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers enforced by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may, within six weeks from the date hereof apply to the High Court for this purpose.
