CERTIFICATES OF TAX DEPOSIT

Whereas representation has been made to me by the Cambridge City Council that a Fair, known as Reach Fair, has been held annually in the county of Cambridge in Rogation Week, and that it would be for the convenience and advantage of the public that this Fair should in future be held annually on the first Monday in May:

And whereas notice of the said representation and of the time when the same would be taken into consideration by me has been duly published in pursuance of the Fairs Act 1873:

And whereas it appears to me after considering the said representation and the objections received that it would be for the convenience and advantage of the public if the day on which the said Fair is used to be held were altered.

Now therefore I, the Right Honourable Merlyn Rees, M.P., one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, in exercise of the power conferred upon me by section 6 of the Fairs Act 1873 do hereby order that the said Fair shall be held annually on the first Monday in May.

HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971

The Fishguard-Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (Afon Soden Improvement) Order 197

The Fishguard-Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (Afon Soden Improvement Side Roads) Order 197

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:

1. an Order under section 7 of the Highways Act 1959 providing that a road which he proposes to construct at Synod Inn in the County of Dyfed shall become a trunk road as from the date when the Order comes into operation; and
2. an Order under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959 authorising him:

- (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways;
- (b) to stop up highways;
- (c) to construct a new highway (which will be a footpath) to connect footpath 51/73 with the above-mentioned Trunk Road;
