LEWISHAM LONDON BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The London Borough of Lewisham (Car and Lorry Parking) Order 1977*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Lewisham proposes to vary the above Car and Lorry Parking Order made under section 31 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 in the following respects:

- (i) to provide for the imposition of an excess charge of £5 in respect of private motor vehicles which are left in car parks with "Pay and Display" meters without a valid parking ticket, such charge to be reduced to £2.50 if paid within 14 days;
- (ii) to extend to private motor cars in car parks with "Pay and Display" meters the rules already governing commercial vehicles, relating to the method of display of parking tickets, and the payment of excess charges, save that the period within which payment of excess charges is to be required will be 28 days;
- (iii) to alter the hours of operation of the Blackheath Station Goods Yard Car Park; and
- (iv) to alter the charges payable in respect of the undermentioned parking places as follows with effect from the 1st April 1979.
