

The Trunk Road (High Street, Skipton (A59)) (Box Junction) Order 1979

The Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, on the North-West of Doncaster-Kendal Trunk Road (A59) in the District of Craven in the County of North Yorkshire.

The effect of the Order which comes into operation on 28th February 1979 is to install a boxed area on that length of the trunk road known as High Street, Skipton, being the area at its junction with the access road to the Town Hall Car Park.

Drivers may not cause their vehicles to enter the boxed area unless their exit is clear.

Exceptions have been provided in the Order so as to allow the driving of a vehicle into the boxed area by a person who wishes to make a right-hand turn and who is then prevented from driving out of that area by reasons only of the presence of other stationary vehicles in or near that area; or vehicles being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision in, the Order, on the ground that it is not within the powers with respect to the Order conferred by the above Act, or on the ground that any instrument made under, any provision of that Act has not been complied with in relation to that Order, may within 6 weeks of 19th February 1979 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or any provision contained therein.

THE IMPORTED FOOD REGULATIONS 1968, AS AMENDED

France: Official Certificate

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Wales acting jointly give notice that, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Imported Food Regulations 1968 (S.I. 1968 No. 97) as amended by the Imported Food (Amendment) Regulations 1973 (S.I. 1973 No. 1351) and the Transfer of Functions (Wales) (No. 1) Order 1978 (S.I. 1978 No. 272), they hereby restrict recognition of the Official Certificates reproduced in the First Schedule to the notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 13th October 1978 for the importation of poultry meat from France to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

The Second Schedule to the notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 13th October 1978 is hereby revoked.
