THAMESDOWN BOROUGH COUNCIL

Scheme for the establishment of crossings for foot passengers in the Borough of Thamesdown

Notice is hereby given that the Thamesdown Borough Council, acting as Agents for the Wiltshire County Council, pursuant to an Agreement made under the provisions of section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, have obtained the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport to a variation contained in the scheme for the establishment of crossings for foot passengers in the Borough of Thamesdown made by the said Thamesdown Borough Council on 9th July 1975, and approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment on 27th August 1975, that Pelican Crossings be installed in the lengths of roads referred to in the Schedule hereto.

Maps showing the lengths of roads indicating the crossings may be inspected at the offices of the Director, Technical Services, Thamesdown Borough Council, Civic Offices, Swindon, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the variation on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instruments made under it has not been complied with in relation to the variation may, within six weeks from 26th February 1979, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
