*The North Shropshire District Council (Public Footpath No. 50, Baschurch) Diversion Order 1979*

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order, made on 25th January 1979, is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed as an unopposed Order by the North Shropshire District Council.

If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted with the Order.
