TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 to authorise the stopping-up of the length of highway described in the Schedule to this notice to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of that Act.

Copies of the Order may be obtained free of charge, on application to the Secretary of State, Welsh Office, Transport and Highways Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL (quoting the reference number WR15/71/26) and may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the offices of the Cardiff City Council, City Hall, Cardiff.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 11th May 1979 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

The length of highway to be stopped up is at Cardiff in the County of South Glamorgan and is that length of Hill's Terrace which extends from its junction with Hill's Street in a south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 67 yards.
