### The County of Dorset (The Plocks and Sheep Market Hill, Blandford) (On Street Parking Places) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 30th May 1979 the Dorset County Council made an Order under sections 28 (1) and 31 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972.

When this Order comes into operation on 1st June 1979 the present off-street car parking Order will be replaced with the correct on-street parking Order as these roads are designated highway.

In effect the Sheep Market Hill parking will change from a 2 hour limited waiting period to a 1 hour. There will be no change to the limited waiting period at the Plocks. There will also be unlimited waiting at both parking places on Sundary Sundays.

The County of Dorset (Various Roads, Swanage) (Prohibi-tion and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1969 (A:nendment) Order 1972 (Amendment) Order 1979.

Notice is hereby given that on 30th May 1979 the Dorset County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

When this Order comes into effect on 1st June 1979 the existing Order will be amended as follows:

- A. Waiting will be prohibited at any time on the following lengths of road:
  - De Moulham Road, on its eastern side, between its junc-tion with Victoria Avenue and a point 15 metres north of that junction.
  - Gilbert Road, on its eastern and northern sides, for its entire length.
  - Shore Road, on its eastern side, between a point 29 metres north of a point opposite its junction with the northern side of Victoria Avenue and a point 19 metres south of a point opposite its junction with the southern side of Victoria Avenue.
  - Victoria Avenue, on its southern side, between its junction with the western side of Back Rempstone Road and its junction with the eastern side of Rempstone Road.
  - Rempstone Road, on its eastern side, between its junction with Victoria Avenue and a point 11 metres north of its junction with the northern side of Gilbert Road.
  - Ilminster Road, on both sides, between its junction with Gilbert Road and a point 9 metres north thereof.
- B. Waiting will be limited to 1 hour in any 2 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday on the following length of road:
  - High Street, on its north-eastern side, between a point 15 metres south-east of a point opposite its junction with the eastern side of Seymer Road and a point 15 metres north-west of its junction with the northern side of Encombe Road.
- C. Waiting will be prohibited at any time between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. 15th May to 30th September both dates inclusive on the following length of road:

B

Shore Road, on its eastern side between a point 46 metres north of a point opposite its junction with the northern side of Battle Gate footway and a point 29 metres north of a point opposite its junction with the northern side of Victoria Avenue.

(N.B. The length of Shore Road at present the subject of waiting restrictions between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7.30 p.m. during the period 15th May to 30th September will be amended to the above and waiting will now be prohibited between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. 15th May to 30th September.)

D. Waiting will be prohibited at any time between 15th May and 30th September (both dates inclusive) on the following lengths of road:

Rempstone Road, on its western side:

(i) between a point 11 metres north of its junction with the northern side of Gilbert Road and a point 9 metres south of its junction with the southern side of Cranborne Road; and

(ii) between a point 9 metres north of its junction with the northern side of Cranborne Road and a point 9 metres south of its junction with Victoria Avenue.

E. Wating will be limited to 1 hour in any 2 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday between 1st October and 14 May (both dates inclusive) on the following the off model. following lengths of road:

Rempstone Road, on its western side:

(i) between a point 11 metres north of its junction with the northern side of Gilbert Road and a point 9 metres south of its junction with the southern side of Cranborne Road; and

(ii) between a point 9 metres north of its junction with the northern side of Cranborne Road and a point 9 metres south of its junction with Victoria Avenue.

- Shore Road, on its eastern side, between a point 19 metres south of a point opposite its junction with the southern side of Victoria Avenue and a point 219 metres south thereof.
- Exceptions will be included in the Order for:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
  (b) loading and unloading goods;
  (c) disabled persons vehicles bearing the relevant "orange" badge;
  (d) delivering and ulloating possible parts of the part of the par
- (d) delivering and collecting mail by Post Office vehicles; and where necessary in connection with:

  - (e) the maintenance of the roads;
    (f) the supply of gas, water or electricity;
    (g) any building or demolition operation or the removal of any obstruction to traffic;

(h) works in connection with any telegraphic line; and

(i) emergency service vehicles.
